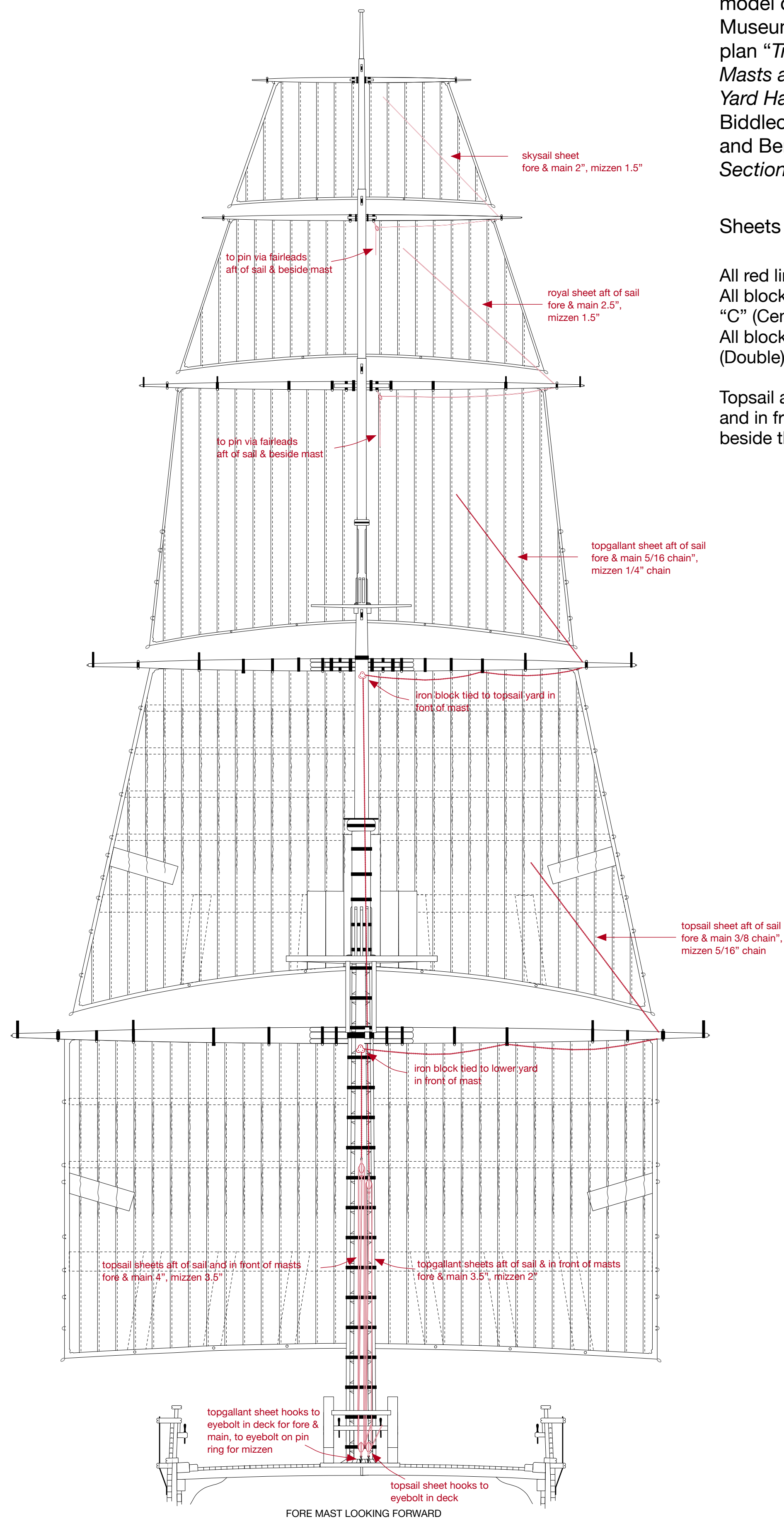

Sheets shackled to clue lines.

All red lines p&s except where noted
 All blocks p&s except those marked "C" (Center), "P" (port) or "S" (starboard)
 All blocks single except those marked "D" (Double) or "T" (triple)

Topsail and topgallant sheets are aft of sails and in front of the masts, other sheets are beside the masts
