



According to multiple sources, mast pendants were common on clipper ships of the period. I have not been able to find and on the Boucher 1916 model of the *Flying Cloud* in the Boston Museum of Fine Arts. Note that many clippers apparently had a pair of mast pendants on each side of each mast, one on the forward edge of the mast and one on the aft edge. I have only shown one per side of each mast.

The Boucher model does include a fish tackle pendant (used to raise the anchor) hung from the topmast running over the front of the fore topsail and fore course which I have included.

Rope sizes are from George Biddlecombe's 1848 *The Art of Rigging*.
